




Public Regulated Service, PRS

- Encrypted service
- More resistent to jamming and other intelligent attacks
- Intended for accredited users, e.g. first responders and critical infrastructure
- Developed for increased resilience during crises and other incidents



Decision No 1104/2011/EU

- All nations that intend to use PRS shall have a Competent PRS Authority (CPA) that designs and controls the national use
- Nations shall according to "1104" fulfil certain minimum standards, e.g.:
 - Developing national infrastructure
 - Receiver integration, key distribution, document distribution, etc
 - User group organisation
 - Definition and management of access rights for PRS users
 - Security management
 - Reporting of detected potentially harmful electromagnetic interference affecting the PRS
 - ...




Work done so far

- Collecting user needs
- Acquiring the task

 - Coordinating nominations for relevant EU committees and working groups
 - Recruiting/procuring manpower
- Initiating technical studies
 - Early studies of receiver concepts
 - Detection of jamming/spoofing

- Developing a national policy for critical applications
